Kure It's Rivals Cup A Success UCLA & USC Receive \$550K For Cancer Research

Kure It hosted its *Second Annual Rivals Cup Golf Tournament* on Friday, June 7th at Pelican Hill Golf Club in Newport Beach, CA. This event brings together long-time rivals, UCLA Bruins and USC Trojans, as they raise funds for vital cancer research for each school's Comprehensive Cancer Center.

As part of our \$1M in grants for 2019, both UCLA Jonsson and USC Norris Comprehensive Cancer will receive \$275,000 in grants from our Rivals United for a Kure campaign. Researchers representing each school were present to accept on their behalf.

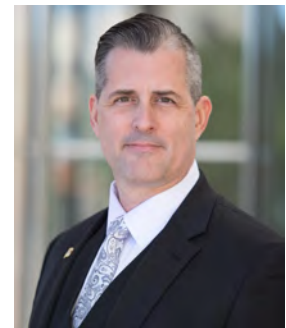
Kure It Welcomes New Board Members
